Credit card payments are authorized and processed directly from within the MAS 90 and MAS 200 applications. All transactional information, such as authorization codes, is captured and stored within the appropriate application database for historical and reconciliation purposes.

And the system's fraud-prevention features protect both you and your customers from unauthorized credit card usage.

MAS 200 - Benefits of Client/Server

MAS 200 is the client/server version of MAS 90, and it provides much better performance on local networks of five or more users. It also allows MAS 90 to run over wide area networks, connecting branch offices and remote users to a central server. Individual users can connect via modem, but for better performance (and as a requirement for branch office connections) we recommend connecting via a high-speed internet connection. A Virtual Private Network (VPN) lets you use the public internet securely, and at much lower cost than dedicated digital lines.

At Friendly Systems, we have a business DSL line at our Atlanta office, and connect via VPN from our home offices which have cable modem connections to the internet.
